

## CMS Standard Student Attire

### 2013-2014

- **Pants:** Plain/ solid black, or tan/Khaki fitted at the waist
- **Shorts:** Plain/solid black or tan/khaki fitted at the waist, 2 inches above the knee or longer, **cut offs are not allowed at Carson Middle School**
- **SKIRTS/DRESSES ARE NOT ALLOWED**
- **Shirts:** Navy or White 3 button polo (long or short sleeve), Shirt may either have CMS logo or be plain, solid, logo-free. Shirt must be tucked in. Outermost layer worn is the approved polo shirt or approved sweater.
- **Sweatshirt:** Navy or white crewneck sweatshirt or cardigan may be worn over polo shirt. Sweatshirts may not have lettering or logo's visible unless they the logo is CMS. Polo shirt must be tucked in and collar out and visible. **Hoodies are not allowed at Carson Middle School.**
- **Undershirt:** Plain/Solid white or black may be worn under the polo. Any visible part of the undershirt must be solid/plain black or white.
- **Belt:** (optional) If a belt is worn, it must be appropriate for school. Belts must have less than a 3 inch tail extending from the buckle, be free of gang insignias, spikes, chains, or logos and lettering.
- **Shoe:** Choice will remain the discretion of students and their parents; however, the CCSD/CMS dress code guidelines remain intact. Shoes with soles must be worn. All shoes requiring laces must be laced and tied appropriately.
- **Accessories:** Jewelry and make-up will still be allowed, again in accordance with CCSD/CMS dress code policy.
  - Scarves shall be treated as an accessory if they are lightweight, decorative scarves. Heavy, oversize, winter scarves are considered outerwear
- **All clothing with the exception of school purchased clothing must be free of slogans, logos, insignias, brand names, trademarks, messages, gang insignias, wording, pictures, studs, jewels, and chains.**
