


# Remote Area Medical In Northern Nevada

RAM is an international organization that travel the country and throughout the world providing free medical services with no qualifications. This event is for those in Northern Nevada who are uninsured or undersinsured, with no eligibility requirements and no ID necessary. All services are provided on first come, first served basis. Please bring a list of medications you are currently taking.



## Dental Services

Given that poor dental health can affect a patient's overall health and result in serious medical problems, a single visit with a dental professional can address many dental health issues and therefore improve a patient's overall health outlook.

Essential dental services provided at RAM clinics include: cleanings, fillings, and extractions, plus may include restorative procedures.

## Vision Services

For many patients a pair of glasses may allow them to drive more safely, to keep or obtain a job, and/or to read a book for the first time in many years.

Essential vision services provided at RAM clinics include: basic screenings, refracting, eye exams, and eyeglasses for patients receiving a prescription.

*Please Note:* RAM may not be able to make all prescriptions. Slit lamps are also available for more extensive eye exams when medically indicated.

## Medical Services

Essential medical services at RAM are dependent upon local resources and can include general medical consultations, diabetic screenings and education, mammograms, PAP smears, and other specialty services. Generally, medical services are limited because extensive services are not likely to be effective with just one visit.
